This is not a thesis statement. The reason why this can not be termed as a thesis statement is its simple nature and absence of a link that adds anything in the information of the reader. The reason why the thesis statement for an informative essay is different because of its different nature. Throughout the informative essay, you will be providing new information to the readers and it compels the **essay writer** to develop it in a different manner. If the writer makes any mistake in writing the thesis statement in the informative essay, it may ruin all his attempts to elaborate information in the essay.
